AN OVERVIEW OF
COLLECTIVE MARKS**

The Collective Marks are the frame around the picture of the test. They should reflect the body of the test. The basic principles must always prevail and these are to fulfill the requirements of the Pyramid of Training.

This session will cover:

1. Components of each Collective Mark
2. How to arrive at a score and how to make a helpful comment
3. Formulating "Further Remarks" that will summarize the important aspects of the test in a way that will be helpful to the rider
4. The biomechanics of the rider to help arrive at scores and comments for the Rider Scores in the Collective Marks

The Collective Marks should be a reflection of the entire test and a summary of the performance of horse and rider.
