- 9. Helmet and Boots required, show coat, stock tie and braiding optional. (No sleeveless shirts)
- 10. Entries received after closing date and changed entries are subject to a \$10 per class fee.
- 11. Entries received without payment will be charged a \$15 incomplete entry fee. No Fax, email, or text entries. Accepting a late entry, the responsible party will be liable to pay all class, office, stable and other fees. Withdrawing will not excuse payment of fees.
- 12. No Refunds after closing date.
- 13. If show moves to rain date, there will be no refunds, unless rain date is rained out (less office fee.)

Tests allow ringside trainer assistance, headsets, bell boots, wraps, and similar equipment. All equipment must comply with reasonable humane guidelines.

This is not a separate class. You will be riding in the general USEF class of your choice, but will not be placed.
